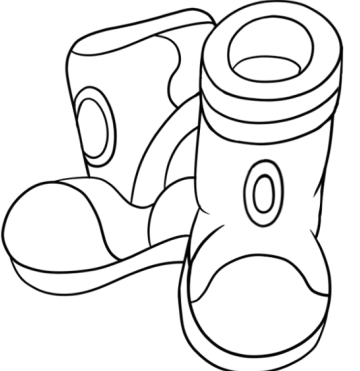
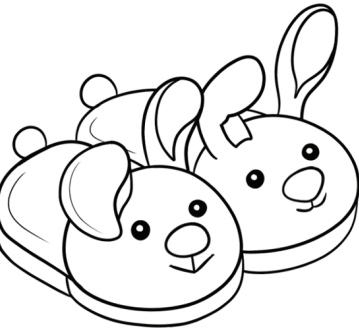




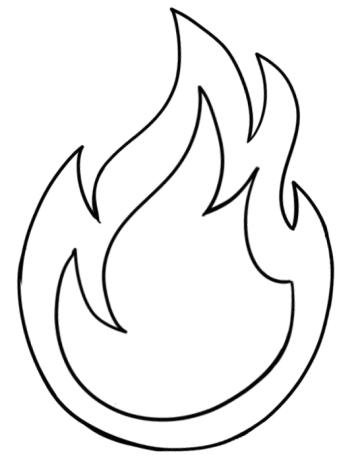
Do not be scared of my gear. Firefighters are here to protect you. Circle the right items for me to wear.



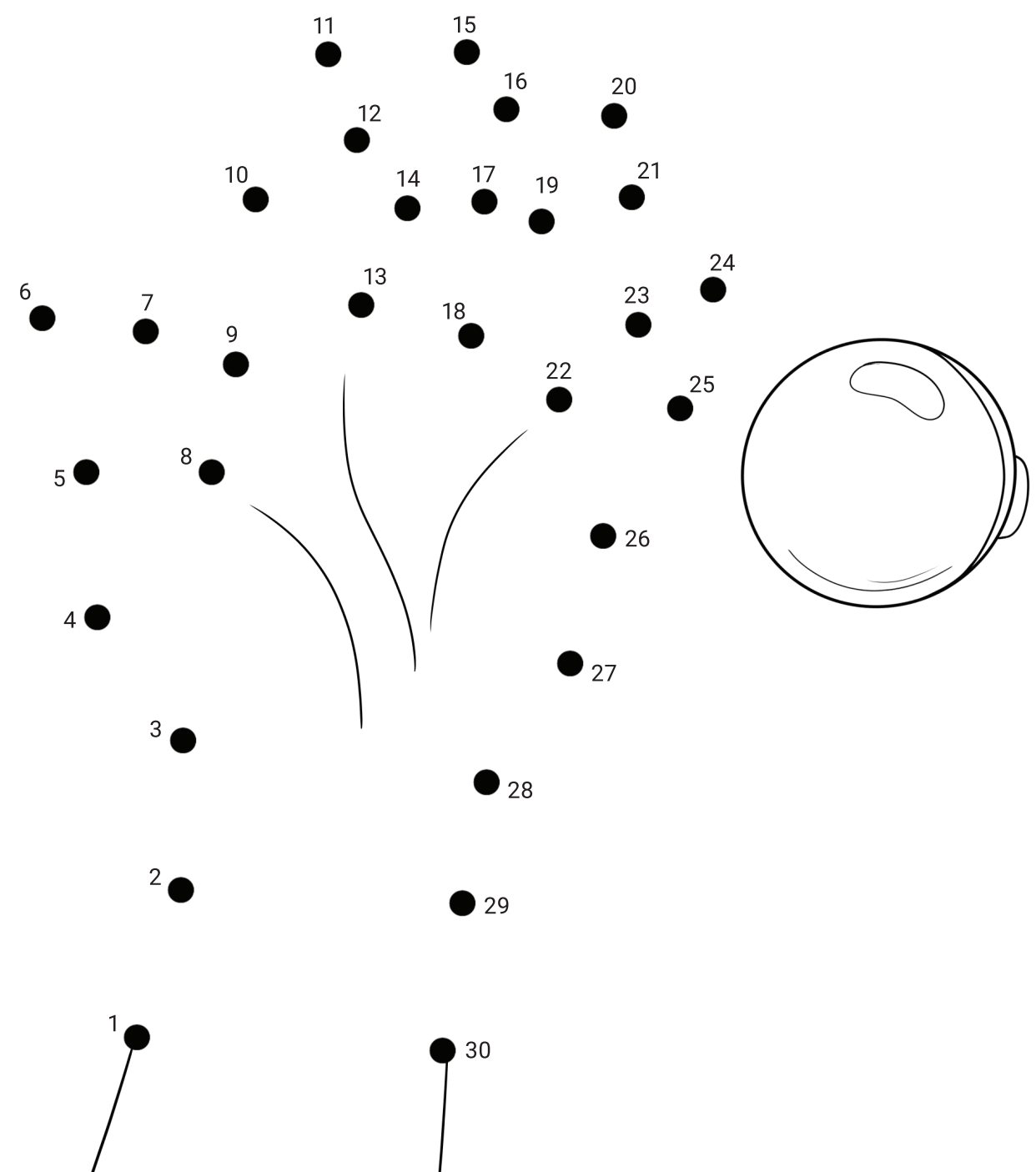
Fire can be dangerous, so we do not play with it. Circle which objects are safe to touch.

know what to do.



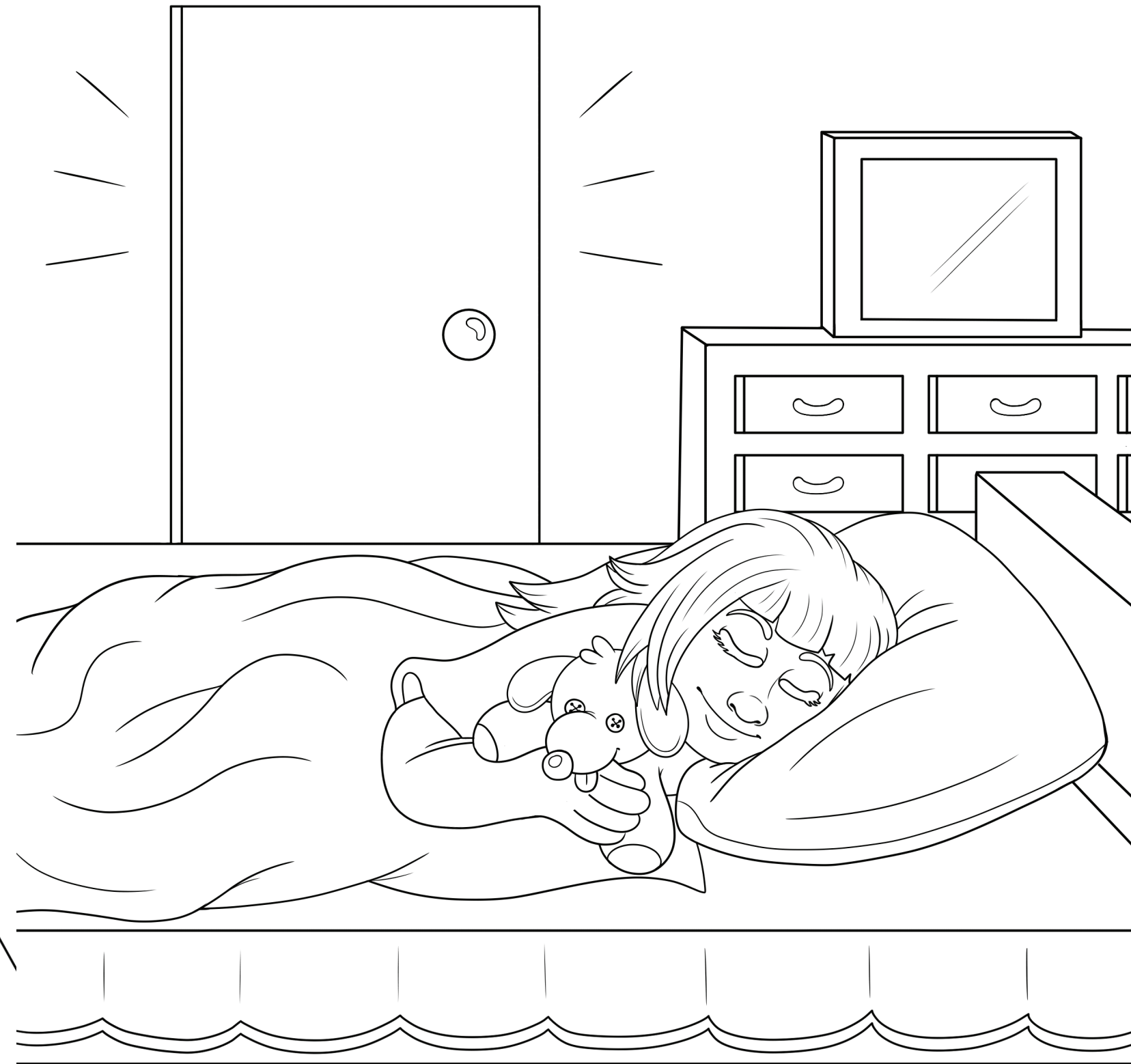
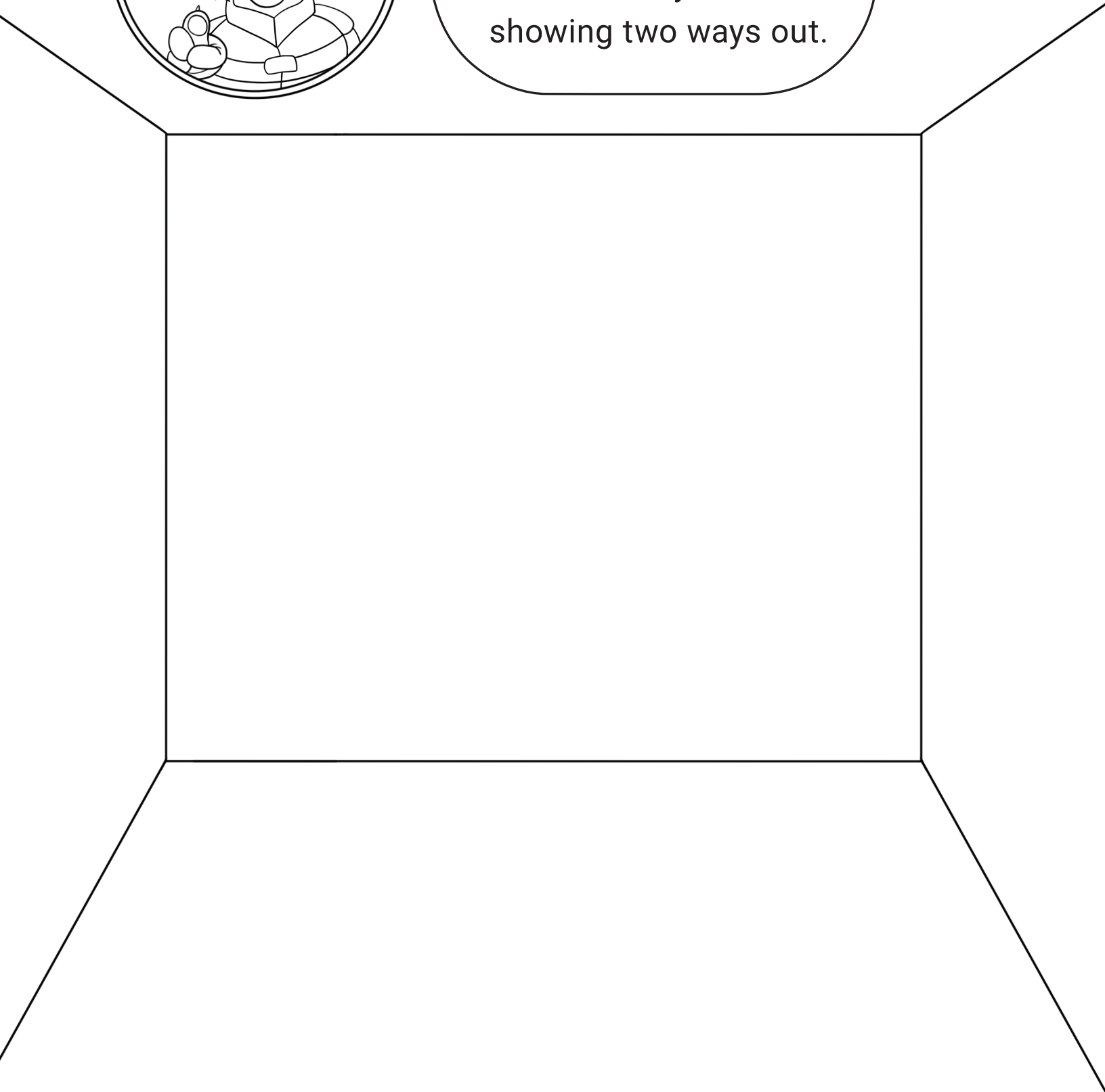
Never open a door that

Do not hide, find a door or a window to exit your room. Draw your room showing two ways out.

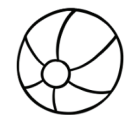
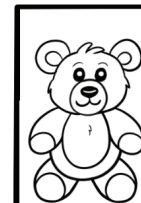
Make sure to sleep with your bedroom door closed. It can prevent a fire from spreading.

where they are.



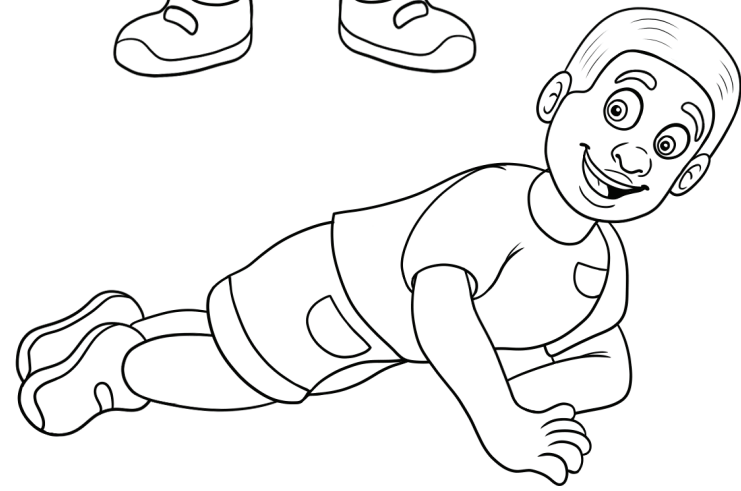
